- Keep the Midlands Beautiful asks participants to follow these guidelines:
- *Remove all lights, tinsel and ornaments from the tree. Also remove tree from stand.*
- *Drop off trees only. Wreaths, garland and other greenery are not accepted.*

Remove tree from bag. Also remove, any string, wire or ties on the tree.

Free mulch made from the recycled trees will be available to the public at the following two locations on Saturday, January 13 from 8:30 AM until the mulch runs out:
