PalmettoPride/Keep South Carolina Beautiful awarded KMB four grants for 2023 in the combined amount of \$23,338; two for Lexington County and two for Richland County. These funds will be used for the Adopt-A-Group programs, WasteWise supplies, a Task Force meeting, and educational materials.
