Public Boat Landings

- **SC Connections Academy**- Gardendale Landing (from JB Barker formerly Metts Landing)
- AVAILABLE - Thomas H. Newman Landing
- **Saluda Shoals Park** - Saluda River from Lexington Landing to the Gardendale Landing and the shoreline within the park
- AVAILABLE - JB Barker Landing

Congaree Creek

- AVAILABLE - Heritage Preserve Trail (2.5 miles) and shoreline that runs next to trail — trailhead is past the water treatment plant on Old State Street.
- AVAILABLE - Congaree Creek at Hwy 321
- AVAILABLE - Congaree Creek between 321 and 12th Street

Congaree River

- AVAILABLE - Congaree River from the Cayce/West Columbia Gate to Congaree Creek
- AVAILABLE - Three Rivers Greenway Riverwalk-Cayce side from Riverfront Park Amphitheater 12th St. (Jarvis Klapman Blvd.) to Hwy 321
- **Cola Church of Christ** - Three Rivers Greenway Riverwalk-Cayce side from Hwy 321 to Railroad Bridge Crossing
- AVAILABLE - Three Rivers Greenway Riverwalk-Cayce side from Railroad Bridge Crossing to Kelly Jones Park
