	DO have a first aid kit and cell phone.		DON'T handle broken glass. Be careful not to step or kneel in areas where there might be hidden broken glass.
	DO look before you step, reach or grab. Watch out for sharp objects, broken glass and natural hazards (bees, fire ants, poisonous plants, etc.)		DON'T bring knives, machetes or other such tools that could cause accidental injuries.
	DO work together as a group and walk facing oncoming traffic. Work one side of the highway at a time.	· 60 · 60	DON'T wear music headsets, which could interfere with hearing traffic.
	DO stay at least 5 feet away from the edge of the road. Do NOT pick up trash from the roadway.		DON'T wear large hats that could obscure your vision and keep you from seeing an approaching hazard.
	DO be alert and ready to react to traffic.		DON'T engage in horseplay.
