Application for an Outdoor Mural from Keep the Midlands Beautiful

Municipal.or.county_owned.locations.are.strongly.preferred; If selected, your town/city council will be invited to help select and approve of your final mural design. KMB will issue a press release, organize a ribbon cutting ceremony and a litter pick up in the surrounding area.
