

## Application for an Outdoor Mural from Keep the Midlands Beautiful

Keep the Midlands Beautiful (KMB), a non-profit organization serving **Lexington and Richland counties** in South Carolina, has received grant funds from PalmettoPride and Keep America Beautiful. We are now seeking several municipalities that would like a **FREE mural between May, 2024 and July, 2025** to help beautify our communities in preparation for America's 250<sup>th</sup> birthday.

**Each mural will share a common design theme** but will be customized for the specific municipality. The murals will say, "Greetings from..." and have the name of the municipality in block letters. The letters and the surrounding area will contain graphics and elements related to:

- South Carolina (e.g. the state bird, the state vegetable, the state grass, etc.),
- The county (e.g. Lake Murray, the State House, etc.),
- Trash and recycling (e.g. a trash can, the recycling symbol), and
- The municipality (e.g. a favorite restaurant, popular business, street sign, famous person, amphitheater, or park).



**Our goal is to inspire pride in the community and to reduce litter.**

Municipal.or.county\_owned.locations.are.strongly.preferred; If selected, your town/city council will be invited to help select and approve of your final mural design. KMB will issue a press release, organize a ribbon cutting ceremony and a litter pick up in the surrounding area.
